Policies and Procedures

Individual Wellness

- Please "self-screen" before entering the building (do not send your child if your child or anyone in the family has any named symptoms of COVID)
- All volunteers and school-aged children are expected to wear a mask upon entering the children's area
- If a child begins to show symptoms the parent will be notified to pick up the child
- Please notify us if the child or anyone in the family has been diagnosed or has been in direct contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.

Drop off/Pick up

- All children's ministry programming will utilize the lower level of the church, as well as the activity center for class time.
- Please do not use the stairs in the Narthex. Drop off/pick-up will be at the end of the ramp in the fellowship hall.
- Parents will not be permitted in the children's area - volunteers will walk children to their designated room/area from the end of the ramp (please follow traffic flow).
 - Please use the same protocol when picking up your child.
- Nursery-aged children will only be allowed to bring what is necessary in a Ziploc bag (no diaper bags). Pacifiers must be on a clip.

Classroom Procedures

- School-aged children will be asked to wear a mask upon arrival.
- Masks are expected to be worn in large group settings; they will be permitted to remove them when seated and distanced from others.
- Children will not be required to wear their mask when participating in outdoor activities where they are spaced apart
- The use of shared supplies will be limited
- A limited contact policy will be used - instead of high fives & hugs we will implement silly waves, elbow bumps and air high fives.

Cleaning

- High-touch surfaces will be cleaned at the end of each hour and as needed throughout the service.
- Toys, books and other items will have a separate set for each hour and will be limited. Used items will be put into a bucket to be sanitized.
